The Plot to Kill Jesus

Scripture: **Luke 22:1-6**

Series: **The Gospel of Luke**

OVERVIEW

Judas' betrayal of Jesus was the worst betrayal in the history of the world. Despite his involvement in Jesus ministry, Judas' wrong expectations of Jesus and his unconfessed sin caused him to betray him. Rather than resist the devil, Judas allowed the devil to enter in. We can also be in danger of betraying Jesus. **Ultimately, though, it was exactly this kind of betrayal that Christ died for.**

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Judas had all of the same spiritual and ministry opportunities the rest of the disciples did. So what happened? Why did Judas end up betraying Jesus?
2. In what ways can we put too much stock in spiritual or ministry opportunities?
3. Why didn't the disciples suspect that Judas was going to betray Jesus?
4. What are 3 signs that show us we're in danger of betraying Jesus?
 - a. *[We spend more time thinking about what we don't have than thanking God for what he has given us.]*
 - b. *[We want God to do something so much for us that we don't care what he thinks is best.]*
 - c. *[We think we're so spiritually strong that we could never betray him.]*
