OVERVIEW

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What is something you are praising God for today? What prevents you from praising Him more?
2. What fears do you need God to deliver you from today? Where do you find joy?
3. What trouble are you facing that you haven't brought to the Lord?
4. How have you recently "tasted and seen that the Lord is good?" What about in the past? How will you do so in the future? What does all this tell us about God?
5. What does your obedience look like lately?
6. Where do you go to seek comfort?
7. How did the sermon define "hope?" [*happy opposition to adversity*] Do you have that kind of hope? Why or why not?
8. Does God feel near right now? Why or why not?
