OVERVIEW

We often tend to gravitate towards pictures of Jesus that suit our personalities or preferences. Those that tend to avoid conflict embrace Jesus who turns the other cheek. Others see conflict as necessary for change and gravitate towards Jesus who overturns the tables. Scripture points us to embrace a fuller picture of Jesus—both gentle and lowly as well as the victorious Savior. **Only a conquering Savior is worth following.**

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Jesus is depicted as a conquering Savior. How has this challenged your view of Jesus?
2. What has your view of Jesus been, historically? How has it changed over the course of the series? Did this sermon specifically shaped your view?
3. What does it mean that Jesus is “faithful” and “true”? How does this impact your faith? How does this affect your prayer life?
4. Jesus as a conquering Savior has implications for the believer and non-believer. What comes to mind for each? How does this encourage you? In what ways does it motivate you to be on mission?
