OVERVIEW

The story of the widow's sacrifice is about much more than money. It's about sacrificial giving modeled by Christ's sacrificial giving - it's giving of our money, time, possessions and even our life. Above all, we must see that **love-driven sacrifice teaches us and saves us.**

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

2. What does love-driven sacrifice look like in your life?
3. Spiritual wealth is greater than worldly wealth. How does (or should) this impact how you look at sacrifice? At giving? At money?
4. Christ's love-driven sacrifice saves us, but it also teaches us. What does it teach us about sacrifice?
5. What should you sacrifice to God? To your family? Be specific.
