## OVERVIEW

2. Do you feel the same kind of remorse that Peter felt when he denied Christ? Why or why not?
3. We are called to confess Christ with our words and our works. Is one easier for you than the other? Why are both necessary?
4. How can you do a better job confessing Christ in the public square?
5. How does growing in holiness help our confession of Christ?
