Sunday, December 6, 2020 Scripture: **Hebrews 10:11–14** Series: **Advent 2020: The Savior You Need**

OVERVIEW

During this season, we watch as childcare wait for Santa. Israel understood what it meant to wait. They long for Christ to come and save them. Christ who would fulfill the roles of Prophet, Priest, King, and be their Lord. Some of us when we hear the word "priest" we get uneasy. - 4. In what ways is Jesus the priest we need? [He atones, intercedes, understands, helps, never quits, fails, or dies]. Which of these is most comforting to you this season?
- 5. What, to you, is a characteristic of the religion of man? [man-made, powered, reliant, centered religion]. Why is it that man-made religion cannot save? How have you seen others gravitate towards man made religion? How have you found yourself doing so?



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
