OVERVIEW

This section of scripture is often looked at as the beginning stages of the development of the diaconate, or the founding of the ministry of the deacons. This is a reminder for all of us of the need for mercy - to take care of those who are often overlooked, those who are vulnerable, and those who are ignored. **The diaconate is the church's example of the ministry of mercy.**
