OVERVIEW

Paul traveled to Ephesus, where Apollos had been ministering, and found that the disciples there also had an incomplete understanding of the gospel. He then baptized them in the name of the Lord Jesus and laid his hands on them, and the Holy Spirit came upon them. Paul preached in the synagogue for three months, but was rejected, so he preached daily for two years in a public place so that both Jews and Greeks heard the gospel. A disciple of Jesus trusts Jesus, imitates Jesus, and perseveres with Jesus.
